This communication is an update being provided to inform the Rialto USD community of the current plans (and possible future plans, should the need arise) related to the Coronavirus or COVID-19. **Below are the latest actions that the District is taking to prevent the spread of this medical threat.**



RUSD schools will be closed from **Monday, March 23**, through **Friday, April 3, 2020**. Schools will reopen on **Monday, April 6, 2020**. Please be mindful that, after Spring Break, beginning **Monday, March 23**, teachers, other certificated non-management and most classified staff will not be required to report to their worksites. However, in order to maintain the essential operations of the District, an adequate number of staff in certain departments such as Safety, Education, Nutrition and Business Services, etc. will report to work as previously communicated. This week, a district team is preparing instructional materials for students to complete during the two-week closure. As this crisis unfolds, we will continue to adjust to the circumstances as required by County, State or Federal officials.
