Checklist for Success Freshman Year

- ❑ Create a four year plan.
- ❑ Talk with your counselor about graduation and 'A – G' requirements.
- ❑ Enroll in challenging classes with support from your counselor.
- ❑ Keep up on your grades! Strive for an 'A' or 'B' in all your classes.
- ❑ Any 'D's or 'F's you will have to repeat the course for UC/CSU
- ❑ Focus on your English and Math classes.
- ❑ Attend tutoring if necessary.
- ❑ Pass Math I. Remember that Math I can be a 'gatekeeper' class, is required for graduation, and is a foundational class for advanced Math and Science classes
- ❑ Start thinking about your long term goals.

- ✓ Do well in your classes NOW ***so you have room in your high school schedule*** to take plenty of great electives.
